Registered Nurse: 0.85 PTE (x1) and 0.5 PTE (x1) – MANA KIDZ SCHOOL PROGRAMME:

The primary purpose of this role is to improve the health of our children for certain targeted preventable conditions and reduce the rate of hospitalisation in primary school aged children for these conditions e.g. rheumatic fever and skin infection. A whanau centric approach is embedded in this programme in order to improve the general health and wellbeing of both children and their whanau.

This role will involve the identification, treatment/management and prevention of sore throat, skin infection and other identified health issues in a school –based health service clinic.

Desired: A Registered General Nurse with at least three year’s experience in Child Health and possibility of working towards a post graduate study in Child Health.
